MOST URGENT

CIRCULAR

Following the direction of the Chairperson, Board of Undergraduate Studies in Political Science, the following circular is being issued.

A confusion was created during U. G. Odd Semester Examinations, 2023 in **Political Science** regarding GE paper for Honours students and DSE paper for Program students. To eradicate such confusion in the forthcoming U. G. Examinations (under CBCS) the following information are sent to the Colleges. The students may be informed accordingly.

- 1) The Honours students of session 2020-2021 will get two options for their GE paper in the 4th Semester Examinations. The students will have to appear in any one among the two, i.e. between Reading Gandhi & Feminism: theory & practice. This will be treated as Old Syllabus.
- 2) The Honours students of session 2021-2022 will get one option for their GE paper in the 3rd & 4th Semester Examinations. The students will have to appear in Feminism: theory & practice in 2nd & 4th Semester and in Reading Gandhi in 3rd Semester Examinations. This will be treated as Revised Syllabus.
- 3) The Program Course students of session 2020-2021 will get four options for DSE paper in the 5th & 6th Semester Examinations. The students have to appear in any one among the four options in 5th Semester, i.e. between Party System in India, Human Rights, Electoral Process in India and Working of Parliamentary Democracy and International Organisation.

The students will have to appear in any one among the four options in 6th Semester, i.e. between Indian Political Thought, India & Her Neighbours, Grass Root Democracy in India and Emerging Trends in Indian Politics. This will be treated as Old Syllabus.

- 4) The Program Course students of session 2021-2022 will get two options for DSE paper in the 5th & 6th Semester Examinations. The students will have to appear in any one of the two options in 5th Semester, i.e. between Human Rights and International Organisations.

The students will have to appear in any one among the two options in 6th Semester, i.e. between India & Her Neighbours and Grass Root Democracy in India. This will be treated as Revised Syllabus.

- 5) Necessary instructions will be given in the question papers in the abovementioned papers.
